This dissertation explores how coworking members are socially connected and what environmental factors are related to their social network formation. Mixed methods were applied to study coworking spaces in New York City in Study #1 to explore coworking space characteristics and the members' social connectivity. Based on the findings, a 2×2 online survey experiment (Study #2) was conducted to examine whether increased spatial-temporal flexibility negatively affects an individual's attitudes toward social interaction in work settings.
